Ms Katryna Tan teaches harp in Singapore and Malaysia and has given master classes throughout Asia. Her harp students are of all ages, from 4yo to senior citizens. She holds a Masters of Music degree in Harp Performance from the University of Michigan, USA. Katryna has held multiple roles in her harp career and her contributions has changed the landscape for harp in the region's music scene tremendously.

As a ***Harp Recitalist***, Katryna has performed internationally and in the region: in Australia, France, United States, Japan, Hong Kong, and in South East Asia countries.

Katryna has appeared as guest soloists with the Singapore Chinese Orchestra, Singapore Armed Forces Band, Braddell Heights Symphony Orchestra to mention a few. Katryna has also performed with prestigious orchestras in the region including Singapore Symphony Orchestra, Malaysia Philharmonic Orchestra, Macau Orchestra and Evergreen Symphony Orchestra (Taiwan).
